AMENDED GENERAL ORDER IN RE
ELECTRONIC FILING PROCEDURES

THIS COURT FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

1. CIVIL ELECTRONIC FILING PROGRAM

On May 2, 2016, the Stanislaus County Superior Court began implementation of an electronic filing program. The Court will not adopt an electronic file at this time, but will maintain a paper file. General limited and unlimited Civil cases will be permitted to be filed electronically, excluding Unlawful Detainers and Small Claims matters. Complex and coordinated proceedings may also be filed electronically.

1 2. PERMISSIVE ELECTRONIC FILING

2 Electronic filing is permissive and is not mandatory at this time. Parties are
3 encouraged to electronically file their documents. Electronic filing is available through
4 the Court's Electronic Filing Service Provider (EFSP). Information regarding the Court's
5 EFSP can be found on the Stanislaus County Superior Court's website at
6 www.stanct.org.

8 3. GENERAL E-FILING REQUIREMENTS

9 All filers shall comply with Rules 2.250 – 2.261 of the California Rules of Court,
10 the Local Rules and the Court's E-filing requirements. Civil E-Filing requirements can
11 be found on the Civil Division's E-Filing page of the Stanislaus Superior Court's website
12 at www.stanct.org. The Court is unable to accept documents that do not comply with
13 these requirements.

15 The receipt and filing of documents submitted electronically is governed by Rule
16 2.259 of the California Rules of Court. The Court amends this order to reflect the filing
17 deadline is 5:00 p.m. (Pacific Standard Time) on Court days. Any filing received after
18 5:00 p.m. will be file marked the next business day. Per Rule 2.259(a)(4) of the
19 California Rules of Court, the filer is responsible for verifying that the Court received and
20 filed any document(s) submitted electronically.
